<p>Prioritise supporting young people to take social action</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to embed the Young Ambassadors in whole organisation, including sharing their voices in the CinCYP programme • Set up a Young Voices group • Training for Young Ambassadors • Source funding for more social action work and pay YA's and young participants for their time/contributions • Creating safe spaces for young people to share their stories, peer to peer education and support
<p>Open up our decision-making structures</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recruit young trustees • Continue to embed the Young Ambassadors • Continue to support our Lived Experience Young Leaders
<p>Work collaboratively with other organisations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Co-develop with young people and other organisations new training and mentorship • Continue to work with schools and create new resources to allow them to better support their young people • Continue talking and sharing to both local and national organisations to champion innovation and best practice
<p>Evidence the benefits of youth social action</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report progress annually through Power of Youth Index • Continue to share stories across our platforms • Encourage case studies produced by the young people themselves
